The caveat is the benefits will be paid to the provider as though the provider is out of network.</p> <p>Humana encourages going with a U&amp;C (UCR) plan and all communication including treatment plan and claims needs to be remitted to Humana in English.</p>
	<p>No, KP does not offer DPPO plans.</p>
	<p>No, MediExcel only offers HMO plans and does not have DPPO options.</p>

 <b>Nippon Life Benefits®</b>	No, there are no providers available in Mexico.
